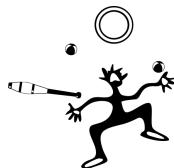

INCENTIVES

Assistants must treat their role **like a job** or even a **coaching internship**. With experience, Assistants can earn tuition credit equal to the camp for which they work.
