



# Juggling Lettering Standards

## JH LETTERING:

- 1) All standards/requirements must be completed by **July 31**—at the end of the lettering year.
- 2) Complete and sign this form. Turn in completed form to Coach Paul by **October 1**.
- 3) Attach check or cash for corresponding JUGHEADS Chenille patch (checks made out to JUGHEADS):  
 1st Year: "JH" Patch = \$25 | 2nd Year: 3 Clubs Patch = \$25 | 3rd-4th Years: Bar = \$10

### Age/Time Commitment Requirement:

- 9th -12th grade in JUGHEADS Youth Juggling Company's Ultimate Club.
- Attendance of Ultimate Club and one other juggling club per week (one club = 2.5 core hours) for a minimum of 150 hours of team juggling involvement from August - July. Time may also include attendance at extra rehearsals, festivals and performances with the team.
- No more than 7 absences (5 excused and 2 unexcused) from UC in one juggling school year.

### Technical Juggling Requirements (any given solo standard may be halved if two others are doubled):

- Achievement of all current Ultimate Club Technical standards.
- Achieve 11 Super-Ultimate Club Standards (by the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> lettering year).

### Performing Standards:

- Publicly perform a juggling specialty act (solo/team) or teach juggling at a venue outside of JH three times within the juggling year which may include Juggle Jam (counts as one) and the EYJA Showcase. The JH director must approve non-JH venues. List **event/juggling act/date**:

### Volunteer and Personal Character Standards:

- Must commit **no fewer than ten (10) hours** between August and July actively teaching others, preferably in a JUGHEADS Rec. Club or Beginning Camp. Assistants may count Officer Meetings toward this standard.
- Must be a role model to the entire JUGHEADS program: behavior, work ethic, attitude, helpfulness to Paul and others, and ambassadorship of JUGHEADS on the road for gigs, festivals and social outings.
- Must avoid behavior that would harm the reputation of the individual or JUGHEADS. Examples: drug/alcohol/tobacco use, violence, sexual impropriety, theft, cheating.
- Must maintain grades that reflect a high academic work ethic and school as a priority. (B /3.0 average or higher).
