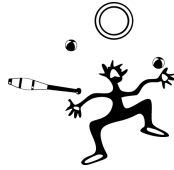

### **INCENTIVES**

**Student leaders must treat their role like a job.** With experience\*, Assistants can earn tuition credit equal to the camp for which they work (i.e., most Assistants simply juggle in the other half of the day or accrue punches for other days).
